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Who is Dr.Haitham Badr

Dr. Haitham Abdulhaleem Badr is a distinguished Jordanian Consultant in Obstetrics and Gynecology, recognized for his advanced healthcare services for women in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia. He currently serves as the Director of the General Administration of Quality at the Security Forces Hospital Program in Riyadh, blending his advanced clinical practice with a leadership role in elevating healthcare standards. Prior to this, Dr. Badr was the Chairman of the Obstetrics and Gynecology Department at the same hospital, giving him profound administrative and operational experience. His contributions extend beyond his clinical duties, as he is a known expert in medical quality and training. He is a certified surveyor for the Saudi Central Board for Accreditation of Healthcare Institutions (CBAHI) and acts as a consultant for various medical and scientific bodies. Dr. Badr is also an active member of training committees within the Saudi Commission for Health Specialties (SCFHS), where he previously chaired the development of clinical assessment units, significantly enhancing medical evaluation standards in the Kingdom. His clinical expertise includes managing high and low-risk pregnancies, performing complex and repeated cesarean sections, and advanced laparoscopic and hysteroscopic surgeries.

Dr. Badr holds the leadership position of Director of the General Administration of Quality at the Security Forces Hospital Program in Riyadh, a role that reflects the institution's confidence in his expertise in implementing the highest standards of patient safety and healthcare quality. He is also a certified surveyor for the Saudi Central Board for Accreditation of Healthcare Institutions (CBAHI), making him a key contributor to assessing and improving healthcare services nationwide. He has played a pivotal role in advancing medical education in Saudi Arabia through his work with the Saudi Commission for Health Specialties (SCFHS). He previously served as the Chair of the Development of Clinical Assessment Unit, contributing to the design and development of numerous advanced training courses for physicians and health practitioners in surgical skills, clinical exams, and Ob/Gyn specialties. As the former Chairman of the Ob/Gyn Department at Security Forces Hospital, he led his medical team in performing rare and complex surgical procedures. In 2019, he led a 19-specialist team in a successful operation to save a fetus with a rare congenital airway malformation. In 2020, he successfully performed a cesarean section on a COVID-19 patient under strict precautionary measures, an event which garnered

significant media attention.

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
