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Who is Fahd Alkandri

Fahd bin Salem bin Ali Alkandri, born on June 28, 1982, is a renowned Kuwaiti Qur'an reciter, Islamic preacher, and media producer. Raised in a conservative environment, he developed a passion for the Qur'an from a young age, beginning to lead prayers at his local mosque at just fourteen. He completed the memorization of the entire Qur'an at the age of fifteen under the guidance of Sheikh Rashad bin Mohammed Sayed Ahmed Allam. Alkandri officially began his career as an Imam at Al-Omair Mosque in Yarmouk in 1999, later moving to Al-Kulaib Mosque in Cordoba in 2001. He has served as an Imam at the Grand Mosque of Kuwait since 2000. His reputation led him to lead prayers internationally, notably at the Mohammed bin Abdul Wahab Mosque in Doha, Qatar, during Ramadan in 2012. In addition to his work as an Imam, Alkandri has made significant contributions to religious media. In 2012, he founded the "ForFrem for Art Production" company, which produced many of his popular television programs. He is widely known for his successful TV series, including "Musafir Ma'a Al-Quran" (A Traveler with the Quran) and "Bel Quran Ehtadayt" (With the Quran I was Guided), where he interviews new converts about their journey to Islam. His approach combines spiritual guidance with high-quality visual production, making him an influential figure, particularly among the youth.

Achievements of Fahd Alkandri

Fahd Alkandri has emerged as an influential media producer and presenter through his widely successful television programs. His most notable works include "Musafir Ma'a Al-Quran" (A Traveler with the Quran), for which he traveled the globe to highlight the stories of Qur'an memorizers, and "Bel Quran Ehtadayt" (With the Quran I was Guided), filmed in several European countries to document the journeys of new converts to Islam, in addition to the "Fasirou" series. In 2012, he founded his own media production company, ForFrem, through which he produces his religious programs with a professional and innovative approach. This venture has significantly contributed to elevating the quality of visual Islamic content in the region. In recognition of his advocacy and humanitarian efforts, Alkandri was appointed as an ambassador for the "Qatar Charity" group for Quranic works in 2013. He has also participated in numerous international Qur'an recitation competitions, achieving high ranks, including first place in the Kuwait International Prize of the Holy Qur'an.

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
