Who is Laila Almeqbali

Laila Almeqbali is a prominent Emirati media personality and actress who began her career in 2004, quickly establishing herself as a strong presence in the Gulf's media landscape. Her name became closely associated with the channel Sama Dubai, where she hosted several highly successful programs. She hosted shows like "Falkom Tayeb" on Fawasel TV and "Aghani Ala Al Talab" on Aghani TV. In 2015, Almeqbali ventured into acting with her debut role in the drama series "Dubai London Dubai," broadcast on the Dubai TV Network. Its success paved the way for her participation in other series such as "Ghamz Al Baroud" (2016), "Mamnoo' Al-Woqoof" (2017), and "Tawq Alhareer" (2023). She is known for her commitment to reflecting authentic Emirati identity in both her presenting and acting roles.
