## Who is Othman Al Khamis

Dr. Othman Al Khamis is a renowned Islamic scholar, hadith specialist, and academic from Kuwait, born on May 26, 1962. ## Achievements of Othman Al Khamis

Othman Al Khamis is recognized as one of the foremost Sunni debaters, gaining prominence for his scholarly debates on Al Mustakillah channel in the late 1990s, where he addressed doctrinal and historical controversies among Islamic schools of thought, solidifying his reputation as a leading authority in this field. He has authored numerous influential books and research papers that have enriched Islamic scholarship, including his PhD dissertation "Al-Muraja'at: A Critical Hadith Study," the book "A Period of History: From the Prophet's Death to the Martyrdom of Al-Husayn," "Treasures of the Seerah," and scholarly rebuttals such as "Exposing Muhammad Al-Tijani." His works address pivotal issues in hadith, creed, and Islamic history. He has held key religious roles, serving as muezzin, imam, and preacher at Al-Humaida Mosque in Kuwait for over 15 years (1989-2004). He has also worked at the Ministry of Awqaf and Islamic Affairs in Kuwait and as a professor at Kuwait University, reflecting his dual impact in both religious and academic spheres.
