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Who is Professor Amir Murad

Professor Amir Murad is a prominent Saudi consultant in plastic and reconstructive surgery with over 15 years of distinguished experience. After graduating from the College of Medicine at King Saud University, he completed his specialization in plastic surgery at the University of Toronto, Canada, where he spent seven years, including a sub-specialization in maxillofacial surgery.
