Who is Rovi Shannat

The "Teta Batta" universe has since expanded to include other characters like her daughter and daughter-in-law, creating a popular digital family. Alongside her digital success, Rovi Shannat has made significant strides in professional acting, participating in notable theatrical and television productions. A key milestone in her career was her role in the play "Nogoum El Dohor" with the acclaimed artist Mohamed Sobhi. She also made a strong impression in the 2024 Ramadan television season with impactful roles. She portrayed the mother of the titular character in the series "Maliha," drawing on her Palestinian heritage to master the role and accent. Additionally, she appeared in the comedy series "Farawla" (Strawberry) alongside star Nelly Karim, and had a role in the series "Sot w Soura" (Sound and Picture), proving her versatility in both dramatic and comedic roles.
